“The Snake of Midgard”

Germany's Hansa-Park in Sierksdorf opened its brand new “The Snake of Midgard” family attraction just in time for the beginning of the new season. The attraction is the park's sixth rollercoaster and a genuine theme-filled adventure for the whole family. Visitor surveying revealed that, in addition to a fast coaster like the “Curse of Novgorod”, a family-friendly coaster was also on visitors' wish-lists. “The new coaster needed to have a lower height and lower lateral forces than ‘Racing Roland’ which itself is 16 meters high”, explained Andreas Leicht, Owner/Manager of Hansa-Park.

of sight from the moving carriages. The Snake's rails are filled with sand, reducing the noise level of the coaster which has an hourly capacity of 500 passengers.

The Viking coaster's special design is an eye-catcher, at least where it is visible, since the ride includes open-air stretches and dark ride sections. The rocky landscape thematization was created by TAA. The lift section is roofed and houses its own scene. The ride's story is accompanied by numerous special effects including fog banks, projections, LifeFormations animatronics and music specially composed exclusively for the coaster.
